ORDER ON PRESCRIPTIVE RELIEF

██████████, a Foreign Service officer with the Agency for International Development, filed a grievance with the Board dated April 16, 1991, disputing a decision of the agency that \$5,552.45 expended by him from an education allowance advance was not an allowable education expense. As interim relief, ██████████ requests that the Board direct the agency to take no action to collect the amounts allegedly due until the grievance before the Board has been decided. The Board has been informed orally that the agency has no objection to a grant of prescriptive relief.

Accordingly, the Agency for International Development is directed to suspend any action to collect from grievant the amounts claimed by the Agency which are the subject of this grievance pending a decision by the Board.
