## ORDER

Grievant on September 14, 1992 filed a motion asking the Board to compel the Department to (1) respond to a supplementary discovery request directed at her reviewing officer and (2) resubmit her original interrogatories to her reviewer with, this time, the five attachments omitted by the Department in its original submission of those queries.

The Board has reviewed the seven new interrogatories which the Department on September 10, 1992 declined to forward to the reviewer. It has also reviewed the five attachments intended to accompany the first set of interrogatories but withheld by the Department. After careful consideration, we deny grievant's two requests.

In our Order of September 8, 1992, the Board set deadlines for responses to outstanding discovery requests, for grievant's final statement or argument, and for the Department's final statement. Those deadlines stand.
