ORDER: SETTLEMENT AND DISMISSAL

On August 31, 2009, the Board received a memorandum from [Grievant] under the subject line: “Withdrawal of Grievance FSGB 2009-001 by [Grievant].” The memorandum was addressed to [Named Person #1] (FSGB), [Named Person #2] (H/RG) and [Named Person #3] (AFSA).

The first paragraph of the message reads:

The purpose of this memorandum is to state that Grievant [Grievant’s Name] wishes to officially withdraw his Grievance (FSGB 2009-001, AGS 2008-089) with the intent to be in compliance with the settlement received on 27 August 2009.

The Board received no copy of the settlement agreement from the parties. However the Board has entered a copy of the memorandum cited above into the Record of Proceedings (ROP) and the ROP in this matter is now closed.

ORDER

The case is dismissed.¹
